REPORT OF THE NAAC PEER TEAM ON Krantiveer Navalbhau Arts College, Navalnagar, District Dhule (MAHARASHTRA)

29th and 30th December 2004

SECTION I : INTRODUCTION

The First Prime Minister of our country, Jawaharlal Nehru, rightly said "If the universities discharge their duty adequately, then, it is well with the nation and the people". Affiliated and constituent colleges are units of the university. If the colleges function effectively then the universities can function adequately. In view of this, it is essential to evaluate the performance of the colleges in terms of their level of academic credibility. This will help us to identify the ways and means of overcoming their inadequacies. From this perspective assessment and accreditation will serve a very useful purpose. The concern of the NAAC is to enhance the quality of higher education.

Generally, the establishment of an institution is the result of dedication and sacrifice of the founder members with the objective of rendering services to the people who have been neglected. Gram Vikas Mandal, Navalnagar started Krantiveer Navalbhau Arts College, Navalnagar, in 1993 with the commitment of imparting education to the people of this area. Its basic objective is to impart higher education to the economically weaker sections of the society in the rural area of this region of North Maharashtra. The management has attempted to promote academic excellence of the college in a short period of 11 years. The college has only one Arts Faculty. The college offers courses leading to BA. There are 7 departments in the Arts Faculty. It is a government-aided college. It has applied for recognition by the UGC under 2F and 12B. This college is affiliated to the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon, Maharashtra.

The college volunteered to be assessed by the NAAC, Bangalore and bmitted its Self-Study Report. The NAAC constituted a Peer Team consisting of Prof.Naresh L. Ved, Vice-Chancellor, Bhavnagar University, Bhavnagar as Chairman, Dr. S.S.Patagundi, Professor and Chairman, Dept. of Political Science, Karnatak University, Dharwad as Member Coordinator, and Prof.S.N..Singh, Principal, G.S. College Commerce and Economics, Jabalpur(MP) as Member.

The Peer Team during their visit on 29th and 30th December 2004 and after validating the Self-Study Report, looking through the existing infrastructure facilities and interacting with principal, faculty members, non-teaching staff, students, parents and alumni of the college, would like to make the following observations on the identified criteria of assessment.

ECTION II : CRITERION-WISE ANALYSIS

Criterion I: Curricular Aspects

A college cannot achieve academic excellence unless it has clear vision and objectives. The ultimate objective of any educational institution is to train and educate young men and women. Here, it is very pertinent to note how we educate our students. In this respect Dr. S. Radhakrishnan has said, "If we want to build a great nation, we must train young men and women who have character". From this perspective, it is very significant to assess the goals and objectives of every educational institution for understanding how our young men and women are educated. The objective of the institution should be reviewed from time to time in this era of globalization.

The goals and objectives of the college are stated in its report. The college has modest goals and objectives and its constituents appear to be keen on pursuing the same for overall development of the institution. In this college, English and General Knowledge are compulsory subjects for SYBA and

Special subjects offered in this college are Marathi, History, Economics and Defense Studies. The teaching programmes are designed keeping in view the goals of the institution and socio-economic conditions of the area.

An attempt has been made to explain how the mission and goals are reflected through the curricula of the college. The curriculum is expected to provide a thorough exposure to the various aspects of life. It is primarily determined by the way in which faculty members teach the various subjects in the college. Faculty members take participation in the workshops on Syllabus Designing organized by the various colleges in the jurisdiction of North arashtra University, Jalgaon. The college welcomes the suggestions and commendations given by the academic peers. The college attempts to organize allous activities for promoting an interdisciplinary perspective to understand the problems of contemporary relevance.

The peer team feels that the subjects like Computer Science, Computer Application, English, Political Science and Sociology should be introduced. Besides, commerce faculty may be introduced. Such subjects will help the students to get more job opportunities.

Criterion II: Teaching-Learning and Evaluation

The programmes of teaching and learning are outlined as per the requirements of the University, the UGC and the Government of Maharashtra. The facilities provided by the college for running the teaching – learning programmes are satisfactory. The performance of the students is evaluated by conducting class tests, tutorials, term-end examinations, seminars, group

One of the student of the ege has obtained third rank in Marathi subject at the University level examination held in April, 2003. The faculty members give special guidance to advanced learners. Besides, the faculty members guide the students for MPSC and UPSC examinations. The college pays attention to the attendance of the students. Guest lectures are arranged periodically to improve the performance of the students. The students of some departments go for regular study tours. This contributes to the improved performance of the students in the university examinations. Usual procedures are followed to recruit teachers as per the norms of the UGC and the Government of Maharashtra. The College has a mechanism for evaluating the teaching work of the faculty members. The strength of the teaching staff of the college is eleven. Out of eleven, eight are permanent teachers, one is PhD degree holder and another one is M.Phil degree holder. There are two temporary teachers on contract base and one is part time.

All teachers of the college stick to the schedule of the University for

Almost all teachers have attended minimum one refresher course and onentation course. Three teachers have attended national level seminars and five teachers have attended state level seminars. Self-appraisal method is followed to assess the performance of the teachers.

Criterion III : Research, Consultancy and Extension

Though the college has 10% of its teachers with research degrees, two faculty members have registered for Ph.D. and one is doing M.Phil. The college needs to pay serious attention to developing research culture.

One teacher is in charge of the extension activities. The broad areas of the various extension activities of the college are social work, health and hygiene awareness, medical camp, blood donation camps, AEDS awareness,

Some of these activities are organized in collaboration with NGOs. The NSS students have built a small dam in a village which is praiseworthy. One of the student of the college has been selected for Zonal level NSS camp held at Chandigarh in 2003. One of the faculty members of this college is a member of Mahila Suraksha Samittee at Deopur station, in Dhule district. The cultural department organizes various competitions such as debate, elocution, music etc. The college encourages the students to participate in sports. A number of students have participated in the university sports meets and brought credit to the institution.

Criterion IV: Infrastructure and Learning Resources

The college is located in a village with 2.4 acres of land. It proposes a master plan for the college campus including the existing buildings. The college has fourteen rooms consisting of library, staff room, ladies' room, study room, gymkhana, principal's cabin, office etc. The college has its specious own playground. The seminar hall of the college is continuously used for various cocurricular and extra curricular activities like debating, seminars, guest lectures, drama performance and cultural programmes. The government of Maharashtra has established a center in this college for its welfare programmes like Pulse Polio. Some of the alumni and present students generate the resources for the college. There is a library advisory committee, which prepares budget and allocates funds for purchasing books and subscribing to journals for the library. The library does not provide book bank facility for the benefit of the students. The library is kept open on working days for 8 hours from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM. The library gets nine journals and some newspapers. There is Xerox facility in the library. The college is going to provide canteen facility. The college does not have hostels. However, the college is planning to construct hostels for boys as well as girls. There is a computer center in the college with five computers for

grounding centralized services. There is a 'Pulse Polio' center in the college under government weifare programme.

The College encourages sports by providing the required facilities. There is a physical education director to guide and train the students. Sik students have participated in the regional level sports meet and two students have participated in the national lievel sports meet. One student has participated in the state-level sports meet. First aid facility is always available.

Criterion V: Student Support and Progression

The drop out rate of the students is not accurately available. During our visit, we found that drop out rate is considerably high. Number of students getting admission for further studies is also not accurately available. Soty and of the students get employment. The college has Alumni Association, which contributes to the growth of the institution. There is no Employment Cell to guide and train students for shaping their career. However, the teachers give informal career guidance particularly for MPSC and UPSC examinations.. The college publishes a prospectus annually. Student support services such as scholarships and college annual magazine are worthy of appreciation. The central government scholarship for SC/ST/NT students and state government instituted scholarships are available. The college provides scholarship of state government for specifications, Physically, gapdicapped, economically backward students and children of primary school teachers and freedom fighters. The evaluation of teachers by the students is a good practice. There is student-teacher-guardian programme. Students take active part in social service programmes.

Criterion VI: Organization and Management

The chairman leads the trust. The secretary and other members help him in coordinating and monitoring the academic and administrative functioning of

the college. The local management committee has been constituted as per the Maharashatra Universities Act, 1994. Both the teaching and non-teaching staff gets representation in the Local Management Committee. This democratizes the functioning of the management. The tenure of this committee is 5 years.

Being a government aided college, the administration is carried out within the rules and regulations of the state government. The various administrative and academic duties are performed as per the direction and guidelines of the management. An in built mechanism of quality checks is added to the efficient aring of the college.

Budgeting and auditing procedures are standardized as per the rules of the state government. The college has deficit budget. The Peer Team feels that the college and the management have to identify the strategy of mobilizing the resources to overcome the problem of deficit budget. Though there is no post of record keeper in the college establishment, the faculty members of various departments are maintained the documents very well.

There is no Grievance Redressal Cell in the college. In case of a grievances relating to the individual staff members, they are addressed to the Principal. Some problems are placed before the management through the local management committee. There are a number of welfare schemes for both and and non-teaching staff. The college has Vijay Nana Shakari Credit

for the benefit of the teaching and non-teaching staff extending loan es. The college encourages to attain the academic excellence. One of the faculty members is a member of Executive Council of North Maharashtra university English teachers Association.

Self-appraisal method for evaluating the performance of the teachers and evaluation of the teachers by the students are very good practices. Analysis of the results of the students in the examinations for working out the strategy to overcome the deficiency of the students is also a good practice.

Regular meeting of parents-teachers association to discuss about the problems of the college is a good practice. Besides, Teachers visiting students' family to understand their personal domestic problems is very good practice. Making efforts to general skill including communication skill of students is a good this college. A faculty member conducts Yoga classes regularly, which asseworthy.

 - Thrust may be given to introduction of certificate / short term job oriented courses on self-finance basis.
 - Career guidance cell has to be established.
 - Efforts may be made to introduce NCC.
